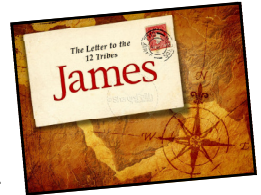

AN UPDATE FROM SOL & ANNA Thank you Cloverfield for your kind gift which we received on Tuesday. We will continue to invest it in the local children. We bought some toys for them as they rarely receive anything. The Lord has been good to us and we have been given daily opportunities to bring Jesus to the folk in India. We are going to help a teenager who is pregnant and due in October who is very poor and unable to purchase basic baby goods which are required. The time here has

flown, we have been here for eighteen weeks! The weather has cooled down according to India now between 32°and 36°. We also have the rare downpour, which attempts to cool things down! We have been very blessed and have had so many opportunities to tell people in India about the Lord Jesus Christ. Through word and deed, we have used every opening to spread the good news both practically and verbally. Sol has had numerous opportunities to preach, to large and small churches with all kinds of congregations; the need here is great both physically, financially but mainly spiritually. We have prayed for hundreds of people, for health, educational, financial and spiritual needs. Wherever you look there is filth, poverty and idol worshipping, but we have been invited to pray and preach to both Muslim and Hindu families. They are so appreciative and our true and living God has answered many prayers. Please continue to support us in prayer and financially so we can continue to give to those in need.
