SAVING FAREWELL TO THE SANDERS FAMILY On the evening of Sunday 14th July there is a BBQ, from 5pm, followed by informal songs of praise to say farewell to the Sanders family as they prepare for the move to Morpeth.

CHURCH MEETING at 7.30pm on Monday, 15th July, in the Children's Room. This is where we make decisions about the life of our church. Do come along and join the discussions.

THE SUNDAY MIX is our monthly, all-age worship time, which takes place in a Café-style format. It is a particularly good event to invite people to if they are new to Church, or have younger children. TSM is always the 3rd Sunday of the month, which is the 21st July and 18th August.

SEEING IT DIFFERENTLY Between the 8th and 18th August there will be a 50ft high Helter Skelter in the Nave of Norwich Cathedral as part of the "Seeing it Differently" project. Climbing the Helter Skelter will give people the opportunity to get very close to the Bosses in the Cathedral Vaulted Ceiling which tell the stories of the Old and New Testament. It is hoped that thousands of people will come to enjoy this experience together with related activities in other parts of the Cathedral and Cloisters which will tell them more about the Christian Faith. On Sunday 18th, from 4.30pm onwards, people from parishes are invited to bring a picnic and enjoy riding the Helter Skelter and other games in the Cloisters. At 6.30pm there will be a special service which will take place in the nave around the Helter Skelter. People of all ages are very welcome! We could get a Cloverfield group together to go along.
