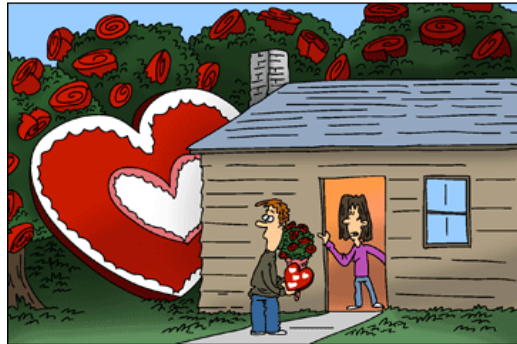

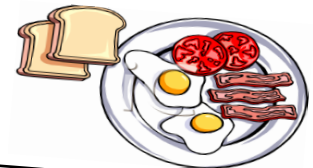

TEAM PRAYER NIGHTS—The next Team Prayer Night is on Wednesday 5th February

from 8-9pm in St. Cuthbert's Meeting Room, refreshments available from 7.45pm. All Welcome. This is an opportunity to pray for the Team Ministry, seeking our new minister, for the churches in the Parish.

NEW WINE DATES—Have you ever thought about going along to New Wine? This is a Christian Festival held at the East of England Showground in Peterborough. Week 1 is 25th to 31st July and week 2 2nd to 8th August. OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD STALL—Operation Christmas Child is a project in which people send a shoebox of gifts to children across the world who would otherwise not receive a gift. The idea is you pack a shoebox, these can be purchased from our monthly stall with gifts which are age appropriate for either a 2-4 years old, 5-9 year old or 10-14 year old. You also need to decide whether your intended recipient is a boy or a girl. Then please do use our monthly stall to purchase items to go into your shoebox. Of course you buy things elsewhere to supplement the box. We ask for monetary donations towards the items we are 'selling'. By using the stall this can help spread the cost of packing a box through the year. Our hope is that the items you purchase go into your shoebox, or more than one if you can to help us beat the 339 boxes we sent off last year. We will be collecting in completed shoeboxes in November.

FAIRTRADE—Cloverfield is a FairTrade church and as such we are committed to use FT products in all our church catering and to mark FT fortnight each year with a special event at the church. This year Shauna is leading a FT service on February 23rd when we will hear stories of the people who grow our food and drinks and who produce the cotton in our clothes, people who are often exploited and underpaid. There will also be an opportunity to buy FT goods from a small stall which will run beside the Shoebox stall that day. Please come ready to support both these good causes. It is possible that the large banana costume may make an appearance too!

EASTER EGG HUNT—Although this is not until 11th April, we are planning ahead to put on this wonderful community event which has become part of the Cloverfield calendar. It can only run successfully with a number of volunteers helping out, either with crafts, refreshments, or just generally being on hand to hide eggs and handout invites to TSM. If you are able to help out please speak to Jean or Corinne who will be co-ordinating the volunteers.
